



Proof of Baptism Required for Sacramental Preparation

In order for your child to celebrate the sacrament of First Reconciliation, First Eucharist, or Confirmation, Saint Michael Parish must have proof of Baptism on record. The original certificate or a copy must be presented to the Faith Formation Office before your child begins preparation for these sacraments (if your child was baptized at Saint Michael Parish, simply complete and return this form. You do not need to present the Baptismal certificate because we have access to the sacramental records). **All families are to complete and return this form by October 6th.** If you are having difficulty obtaining this information, please call our office promptly for assistance. We are more than happy to assist. Please do not wait until the deadline to let us know of your difficulty.
