Reading 2: Philippians 2: 6-11

Gospel: Matthew 26:14 to 27:66

► *For personal reflection prior to meeting as a group (or for discussion):*

1. Have you been able to be calm and helped by God when someone has wrongly accused or even abused you? (This is very difficult!) How can you know when you are not to blame? Who can help you forgive? Will you ask Him, persistently?
2. What personal suffering has been most challenging for you to accept?

3. Who in the passion reading do you most identify with? Why?
4. How has Christ’s passion inspired you to serve others without counting the cost?
