

COVID -19 GUIDELINES FOR ON-CAMPUS MINISTRY

Before Leaving Home

1. Review the following self-screening list: In the last 14 days, have you:
 - Traveled internationally?
 - Been exposed to a person with suspected or confirmed COVID -19 without correct PPE?
 - Had a temperature of at least 100.4 degrees F?
 - Had new or increased shortness of breath or difficulty breathing?
 - Had a new cough?
 - Had at least two of the following symptoms together: chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, vomiting, runny nose/congestion, fatigue
2. If you answered “yes” to any question above, STAY HOME!

While on Campus

Entering and Exiting

- Access to meetings should occur through only one entrance.
- While entering and exiting, social distancing of 6 feet must be maintained.
- Physical distancing must be observed from the time people arrive on campus.
- Must wear a mask from car to car- from the moment you step out of your vehicle, until you return to your vehicle.
- Disinfect surfaces using the products provided in the room; use the product as instructed on the label; surfaces must remain wet with the product for at least 3 seconds.

Proper Hand Hygiene and Respiratory Etiquette

- Upon arrival, wash hands or use alcohol-based (at least 60% alcohol) hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth. Avoid adjusting your mask.
- Masks must be worn at all times indoors and must cover your nose and mouth. If you do not have a mask, one will be provided for you.
- Supervise children when they use hand sanitizer to prevent ingestion.

During the Meeting

- Don't shake hands, high-five or engage in non-socially-distanced greetings.
- Don't share items: water bottles, supplies, etc.
- If possible, increase ventilation by opening windows.

Safe and Effective Disinfection after the Meeting

- Wear disposable gloves to clean and disinfect.
- Steward or Lead must disinfect high touch surfaces, which include: Doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, phones, keyboards, etc.

***If you become ill while on campus, immediately isolate yourself and notify the Steward in charge of ministry.**
