- What are the daily challenges in your life that undermine your inner peace? What ways have you found helpful to restore inner and relational peace?
- What are your favorite Scripture passages that encourage you in times of difficulty? Why do they speak to you?
- Who are the saints in your life to whom you go for intercession in times of distress, difficulty or challenge? Why them?
