Questions

► *For group discussion:*

1. What is your experience with God’s mercy?
2. How are you called to manifest reconciliation, beginning with your personal injuries (“trespasses” received) then looking at your interactions and attitudes in your family, faith community and workplace?
3. Think of a time when you were separated from God. What did that look like for you? What were you joined to?
4. What was your path to reconciliation and repentance? How did God meet you on the way?
5. How is Lent helping you come back to the Father’s house?
