Gospel: Luke 22:14 – 23:56

Questions

► *For group discussion:*

1. How does Jesus respond physically to His own anguish? How do the difficulties in our lives that sometimes do not seem to be answered by God make us stronger and give glory to Him?
2. How is God calling you to be more intimate with him?
3. In what ways have we, like Peter in the Gospel reading, denied Jesus in our lives?
4. What is Jesus eagerly trying to tell you this Lent?
5. Who is someone in your life, Catholic or not, that you want to share the gift of the Eucharist with?
